Size Info This pattern is written for size 7 with changes for sizes 8, 10, 12 and 14 in brackets []'s. Hat Pattern is written for Small (20"-21") with changes for Med (22"-23") and Large (24") in brackets []'s.			
Skill Level Easy			
Special Stitches Shell – 3 dc in same st Double Shell – (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same st			

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Supplies:

- Moda Dea Metro yarn (size 5 bulky weight)
- Size K crochet hook
- Needle for weaving in ends
- 3 Stitch markers
- 2 lengths of ½" organza ribbon

Gauge (always be sure to check gauge):

Row 1 – Ch 21, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk 2 ch's, 3 dc in next ch, sk 2 ch's, sc in next ch, repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2-10 – Sc in same sc, *3 dc shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across. Ch 1, turn.

1 shells + 1 sc = 2 inches

Notes:

End of row counts are enclosed in –()-'s

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Yoke

Row 1 – Ch 74[74, 82, 82, 82], dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across. –(73, 73, 81, 81, 81 dc)-

Row 2 – Ch 2, turn, (counts as first dc now and throughout) dc in next 2 dc, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc (shell made), sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, *shell in next dc, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, repeat from * across to last 3 dc, dc in each rem 3 dc. –(16, 16, 18, 18, 18 shells)-

****NOTE: Double shells count as 2 shells for end counts****

COMPLETE FOLLOWING ROW ACCORDING TO SIZE

Row 3 (for sizes 7 and 8 only) – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, 3 dc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, 3 dc in same dc (double shell made), sc in next sc, *shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across to last shell, double shell in last shell, sc in next sc, dc in last 3 dc. –(18, 18, --, --, -- shells)-

Row 3 (for sizes 10, 12 and 14 only) – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, *shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across, dc in last 3 dc. –(--, --, 18, 18, 18 shells)-

****NOTE: Ch 1 sp of double shells counts as sc when pattern states to sc in next sc****

Row 4 – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, *shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across, dc in last 3 dc. –(18 shells)-

Row 5 - Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, *(shell in next shell, sc in next sc) twice, double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across, dc in last 3 dc. –(24 shells)-

Row 6 – Repeat Row 4. –(24 shells)-

Row 7 – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) 3 times, repeat from * across, dc in last 3 dc. –(30 shells)-

Row 8 – Repeat Row 4. –(30 shells)-

COMPLETE FOLLOWING ROW ACCORDING TO SIZE

Row 9 (for sizes 7 and 8 only) – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, *shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across to last shell, double shell in last shell, sc in next sc, dc in last 3 dc. –(32, 32, --, --, -- shells) GO TO CAPE

Row 9 (for sizes 10, 12 and 14 only) – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, *sc in next sc, (shell in next shell, sc in next sc) 4 times, double shell in next shell, repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc. –(--, --, 36, 36, 36 shells)-

Cape

Row 1 – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, *shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from * across, dc in last 3 dc. –(32, 32, 36, 36, 36 shells)-

Rows 2-X – Repeat Row 1 until cape measures 19"[20", 21", 22", 23"] from beginning. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Weave organza ribbon through Row 1 of Yoke to tie in front.

Scrumptiously Sweet Hat

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Crown

Rnd 1 – Ch 4, sl st to form ring, ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join with sl st to first sc.
–(16 sc)–

Rnd 2 – Ch 1, sc in same st, sk 1 sc, shell in next sc, *sk 1 sc, sc in next sc, sk 1 sc, shell in next sc, repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc. –(4 shells)–

Rnd 3 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, *sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc. –(8 shells)–

COMPLETE FOLLOWING RND ACCORDING TO SIZE

Rnd 4 (for small size only) – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) 3 times, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) 3 times, join with sl st to first sc. –(10, --, --)–

Rnd 4 (for med size only) – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, *(sc in next sc, shell in next shell) twice, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, repeat from * once, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) around, join with sl st to first sc. –(--, 11, -- shells)–

Rnd 4 (for large size only) – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, *sc in next sc, shell in next shell, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc. –(--, --, 12 shells)–

Hat Side

Rnd 1 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, shell in next shell, *sc in next sc, shell in next shell, repeat from * around, join with sl st to first sc. –(10, 11, 12 shells)–

Rnds 2-X – Repeat Rnd 1 until hat measures 16"[17", 18"] from side over top to other side. Fasten off.

Customization Option: You may customize the length of the hat side here by increasing or decreasing the amount of rows.

Weave in ends.

Tie ribbon in a bow around any sc from second to last row of Hat Side.
