Size	Chest	Head Circumference	Yarn Amounts (approximates)
2T	21"	18"/small	8 oz
3T	22"	19"/small	10 oz
4T	23"	20"/med	14 oz
5T	24"	21"/med	16 oz
6T	25"	22"/large	18 oz
<b>Size Info</b> This pattern is written for 2T size with changes for 3T, 4T, 5T and size 6 in brackets [ ]'s. Hat Pattern is written for Small (18"-19'") with changes for Med (20"-21'") and Large (22") in brackets [ ]'s.			
<b>Skill Level</b> Easy			
<b>Special Stitches</b> Shell – 3 dc in same st Double Shell – (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same st

## Supplies:

- Moda Dea Metro yarn (size 5 bulky weight)
- Size K crochet hook
- Needle for weaving in ends
- 3 Stitch markers
- 2 lengths of ½" wide Organza ribbon

## Gauge (always be sure to check gauge):

**Row 1** – Ch 21, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, \*sk 2 ch's, 3 dc in next ch, sk 2 ch's, sc in next ch, repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn.

**Row 2-10** – Sc in same sc, \*3 dc shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn.

**1 shells + 1 sc = 2 inches**

## Notes:

End of row counts are enclosed in –()-'s

## Yoke

**Row 1** – Ch 58[58, 58, 58, 66], dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. –(57, 57, 57, 57, 65 dc)-

**Row 2** – Ch 2, turn, (counts as first dc now and throughout) dc in next 2 dc, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, 3 dc in next dc (shell made), sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, \*shell in next dc, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, sk 1 dc, repeat from \* across to last 3 dc, dc in each rem 3 dc. –(12, 12, 12, 12, 14 shells)-

**\*\*NOTE: Double shells count as 2 shells for end counts\*\***

## COMPLETE FOLLOWING ROW ACCORDING TO SIZE

**Row 3 (for 2T, 3T, 4T and 5T sizes only)** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, (shell in next shell, sc in next sc) twice repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(16, 16, 16, 16, --, -- shells)-

**Row 3 (for 6T size only)** - Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, 3 dc in center dc of next shell, ch 1, 3 dc in same dc (double shell made), sc in next sc, \*shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across to last shell, double shell in last shell, sc in next sc, dc in last 3 dc. –(--, --, --, --, 16 shells)- **MARK AS RIGHT SIDE**

**\*\*NOTE: Ch 1 sp of double shells counts as sc when pattern states to sc in next sc\*\***

**Row 4** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(16 shells)-

**Row 5** - Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*(shell in next shell, sc in next sc) 3 times, double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(20 shells)-

**Row 6** – Repeat Row 4. –(20 shells)-

**Row 7** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, (shell in next shell, sc in next sc) 4 times, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(24 shells)- **2T and 3T sizes only: GO TO Cape. All other sizes continue on to Row 8.**

**Row 8** – Repeat Row 4. –(24 shells)-

**Row 9** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*(shell in next shell, sc in next sc) 5 times, double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(28 shells)- **4T and 5T sizes only: GO TO Cape. Size 6T only: continue on to Row 10.**

**Row 10** – Repeat Row 4. –(28 shells)-

**Row 11** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 3 dc, sc in next sc, \*double shell in next shell, sc in next sc, (shell in next shell, sc in next sc) 6 times, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(32 shells)-

### **Cape**

**Row 1** – Ch 2, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next sc, \*shell in next shell, sc in next sc, repeat from \* across, dc in last 3 dc. –(24, 24, 28, 28, 32 shells)-

**Rows 2-X** – Repeat Row 1 until cape measures 15"[16", 17", 18", 19" ] from beginning. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Weave organza ribbon through Row 1 of Yoke to tie in front.

## Crown

**Rnd 1** – Ch 4, sl st to form ring, ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join with sl st to first sc.  
–(16 sc)–

**Rnd 2** – Ch 1, sc in same st, sk 1 sc, shell in next sc, \*sk 1 sc, sc in next sc, sk 1 sc, shell in next sc, repeat from \* around, join with sl st to first sc. –(4 shells)–

**Rnd 3** – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, \*sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, repeat from \* around, join with sl st to first sc. –(8 shells)–

## COMPLETE FOLLOWING RND ACCORDING TO SIZE

**Rnd 4 (for small size only)** – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, \*sc in next sc, shell in next shell, repeat from \* around, join with sl st to first sc.  
–(9, --, -- shells)–

**Rnd 4 (for med size only)** – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) 3 times, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) 3 times, join with sl st to first sc. –(--, 10, --)–

**Rnd 4 (for large size only)** – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, double shell in next shell, \*(sc in next sc, shell in next shell) twice, sc in next sc, double shell in next shell, repeat from \* once, (sc in next sc, shell in next shell) around, join with sl st to first sc. –(--, --, 11 shells)–

## Hat Side

**Rnd 1** – Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, shell in next shell, \*sc in next sc, shell in next shell, repeat from \* around, join with sl st to first sc. –(9, 10, 11 shells)–

**Rnds 2-X** – Repeat Rnd 1 until hat measures 14"[ 15", 16"] from side over top to other side. Fasten off.

*Customization Option:* You may customize the length of the hat side here by increasing or decreasing the amount of rows.

Weave in ends.

Tie ribbon in a bow around any sc from second to last row of Hat Side.
